They programmed a special AI software for the MobiBox, a handheld that includes all sensors and the intelligence needed to move and steer all kinds of vehicles. It can be plugged into an autonomous air taxi, a self-driving car, a city scooter, a bicycle, or just carried around whenever you move.

enGlobe: 1st digital study project successfully completed

Last October, THI, UFPR and Groupe Renault started our first digital study project in AWARE.

After focusing mostly on theory in the first months, the team of UFPR coordinators and students convinced Groupe Renault with working on 2 challenges at the Renault plant: building an AGV control center (data on DataBase) and improving Data Science routines and indicators.

The continuous hard work paid off and Prof. Wildauer and the whole team presented the results to Groupe Renault.

Another enGlobe project is ongoing: THI's students and students from Universidad Tecnológica Nacional (UTN) continue working digitally on a demonstrator development for a battery-powered drive train in cooperation with Volkswagen Group Argentina.
